Held community charrettes with all planning activities to make sure we are listening to our citizens and give opportunities for their input in their planning process so we develop a collaborative plan based on grass roots input.

## Community Development

In addition to the many new annual events, improvement of the walk-ability of our parks and the expansion of our Mineral Spring Trail. Awarded 2 PRT grants to expand walking opportunities beyond the downtown Mineral Spring Park with plans for further expansion. Beginning discussion on improvement and expansion of Brookdale Park. Addition of new Chris Coleman Pocket Park upgraded and beautified an old water tank site on Main Street.
