



Wren Boys take Runner-up in state

During the first half of Saturday night's game with Lower Richland, the Wren boys appeared to be well on the way to their very first state basketball championship.

But, the second half proved to be a different experience, as the Golden Hurricanes struggled offensively and defensively, while the Diamond Hornets were delivering a stinging attack on both ends of the court.

The end result was a 51-42 triumph by Lower Richland, which claimed its first state title since 1999, while Wren was left to settle with being the runner-up in the second time in as many trips to the Championship Finals.

Coach Fran Campbell saw his Upper-State Champions score the last nine points of the first quarter, and the first six of the second, a 15-0 run overall, to turn a 9-6 game into what looked to be a 24-6 rout in the making.

Looks can be deceiving and they certainly were in this instance, as the Diamond Hornets possibly took offense at some sideline antics by the players on the Wren bench, and turned their displeasure into motivation.

As their starting teammates were taking care of things on the court, the seldom-used reserves were taunting the opposing players by holding

up newspapers in what was considered a show of no respect for Lower Richland.

The Diamond Hornets quickly and effectively responded, putting together an 11-2 rally to close the quarter and go into halftime with a head of steam, having cut that 18-point deficit in half to only trail by nine, at 26-17.

While the newspapers disappeared in the second half, Lower Richland's momentum was still quite present.

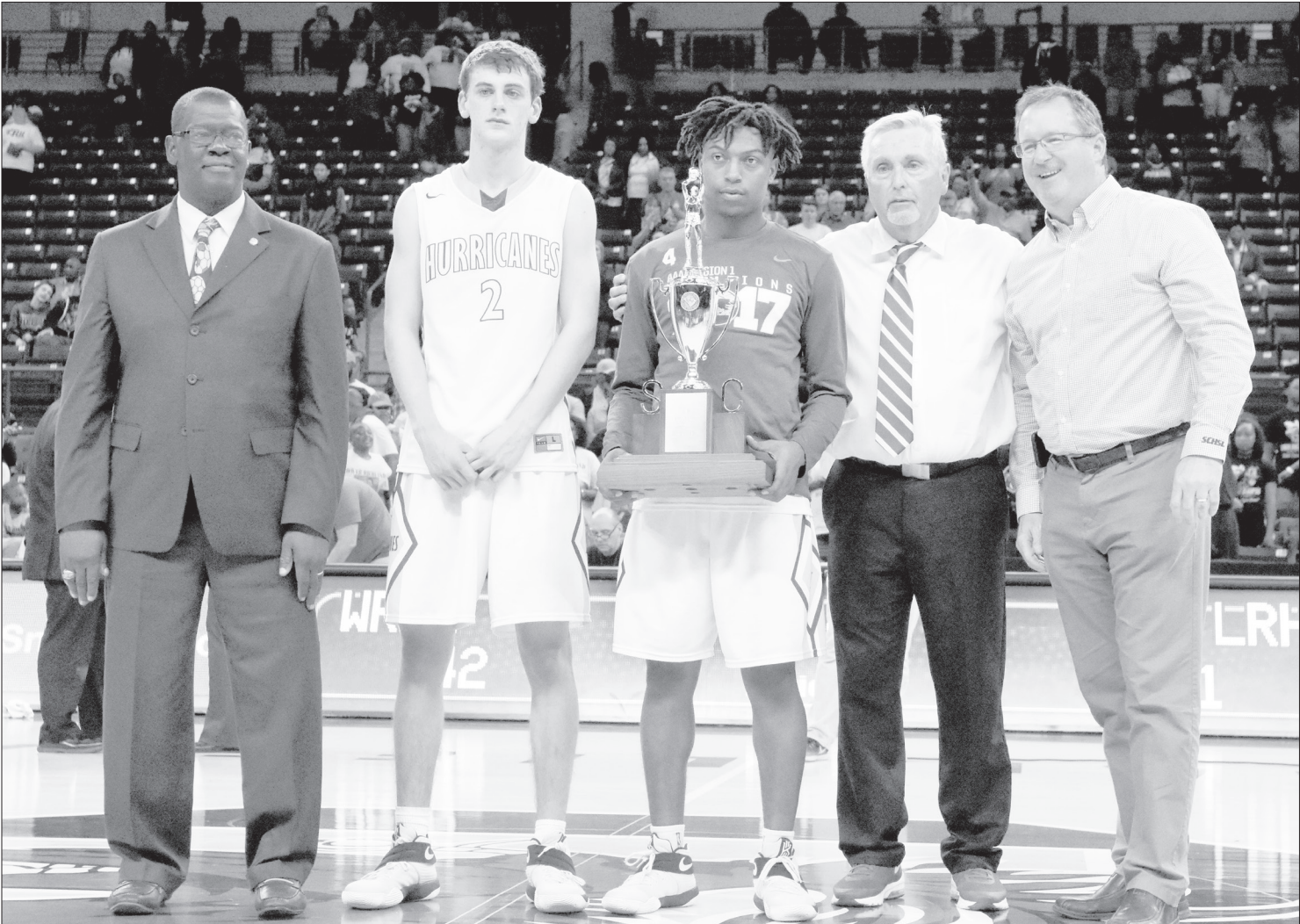
Coach Caleb Gaither's Lower-State Champions kept firing away on offense, and slamming the door on defense, and by the end of the third quarter, had pulled to within, 35-32.

They took only their second, but most important, lead of the night, at 36-35 with 6:58 left in the game, and never trailed again.

Wren was within 45-42 with 42 seconds remaining, but Lower Richland got the final six points to seal the comeback.

John Kanaan was the only local double-figure scorer for the Golden Hurricanes, getting 15 points, while Isaac Ford was next with nine, followed by Cameron Willis with seven.

Trey McGowens had six and Jeremiah Neubia added five more for Wren, which ended the year with an overall record of 23-5.

Gamecocks win third SEC Conference Championship

The top seeded South Carolina Lady Gamecocks competed for their third straight SEC Conference Championship this past weekend at the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament at the Bon Secours Wellness Arena in Greenville.

Friday they faced off against Georgia who defeated Auburn in their first round game. The Gamecocks took the easy victory 72-48 over the Bulldogs.

On Saturday they faced a tougher opponent in Kentucky but managed to hold off the Wildcats 89-77 which sent them to the championship game on Sunday to face the second seeded Mississippi State Bulldogs.

The Gamecocks came out on top defeating the Bulldogs 59-49 to claim their third straight SEC Conference Championship.

The Gamecocks finished the season with a record of 14-2 in the conference and 27-4 overall. They are ranked number one in the conference in scoring offense with an average of 76.2 percent and ranked second in the conference in scoring defense with an average of 57 percent. Mississippi State finished first in scoring defense at 55.4 percent.



For the season the Lady Gamecocks were seventh in the conference at the free throw line at .705 percent and first in field goal percentage at .470. In 3-point field goal percentages the Gamecocks came in 6th at .333 percent.

Rebounding offense had the Lady Gamecocks at fourth at 39.4 percent and rebounding defense they were fourth at 33.2 percent.

The Lady Gamecocks were first in the conference in blocked shots at 5.8 per game, and had 8.6 steals per game tying with Florida for fifth.

Offensive rebounds had the Gamecocks eighth in the conference at 12.6 per game and defensive rebounds at 5th at 26.8 per game.

Quote from Coach Dawn Staley about having to be resourceful against Mississippi State after losing Alaina Coates to injury: Not having Alaina Coates makes you do a lot of different things. You have to make adjustments because there's a huge void left, not just this year, but she's been a mainstay for us for the past four years. She's been a big part of our program. But our players are truly resilient. They want to do anything they can do to help our team win. That's growth that's taken place over the entire year. 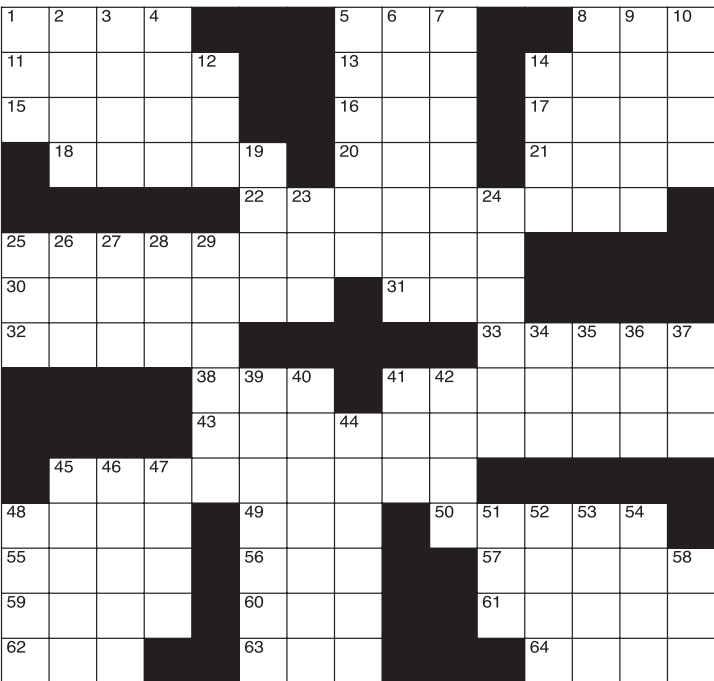

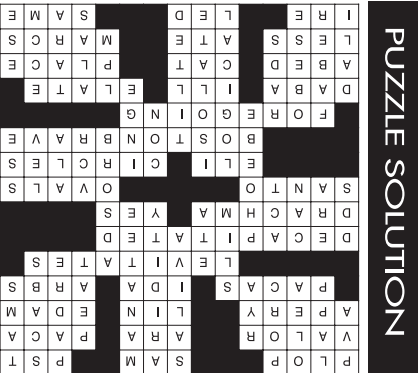
